

Beaufort Hunt Supporters Club Show

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Covid-19 Rules and Guidance

The Beaufort Hunt Supporters Club's key priority is to protect the health, safety and well-being of our visitors to the show be it the competitors, volunteers, supporters and judges. We therefore ask that you to adhere to the guidance in place to ensure everyone has an enjoyable and safe day out.

Thank you for your support, and we look forward to seeing you on the day.

General

Social distancing is to be practised at all times.

Hand sanitiser will be provided at key points across the showground.

The following visitors must not attend under any circumstances:

- Those in self-isolation (either with Coronavirus or living in a household with Coronavirus)
- Those defined as Clinically Extremely Vulnerable (CEV)

Entries

As much as possible entries and payments to be completed online in advance of the show date. Any entries on the day are accepted, measures are in place to manage this.

On arrival at the show, all entries and contact details will be checked at the gate. We cannot admit spectators unconnected to the competitors. Contact details of all passengers will be recorded in accordance with the Government Track and Trace Scheme. These will be held securely by the organisers and destroyed 21 days after the event.

Parking

Parking will be designated in accordance with social distancing regulations. Please adhere to the directions on the day.

Warm Up

Tacking up to take place within the designated parking area.

Maximum numbers in the warm-up area should not exceed four people at any one time.

For the jumping and dressage rings, due to social distancing and 3 minutes per round in the ring, warm-up time is limited to 12 minutes. An additional grass area will be provided for exercise.

No spectators or grooms are allowed to access the warm-up area. A Beaufort Hunt volunteer will be present to put up the poles.

Riders should maintain a distance of five horse lengths apart from other competitors at all times.

Dressage

Dressage tests will not be available on the day.

They can be emailed upon request after the show or posted with an SAE supplied by the competitor on the day at the Secretaries tent.

Showing and Utility Classes

All lead rein classes must be led by a member of the same household.

Competitors will be limited to six per group in the ring at any one time. The Judge will view all groups and select those to come back in. Please bear with the estimated times for popular classes.

The Judge will not ride for any of the hunter classes.

Jumping Classes

One competitor to be in the ring at any one time.

A strict one way system will be in place for all rings to allow safe entry and exit.

Gymkhana

All lead rein classes must be led by a member of the same household.

In order to adhere to social distancing and government guidance, some of the advertised races may be changed or altered.

Leaving

Once you have completed your classes, return to the designated parking area to untack and load up prior to leaving the show.
